

COVID-19 PROCEDURES FOR PERSONAL USE OF CLUB KAYAKS/CANOES BY CLUB MEMBERS FOR NON-CLUB EVENT

FFOFC is doing everything it can to protect club members and the public during the pandemic crisis. Therefore, we have cancelled all group events/gatherings until further notice. We do however understand that members may wish to borrow club kayaks/canoes for solo or family outings. To this extent, the club has outlined below the procedures to be followed by members borrowing kayaks/canoes and the procedures for club representatives transferring the boats to members.

Members wishing to borrow boat(s) will contact the Water Sports chair to schedule a time and place to pick up the boats and a time and place to return the boats. The member(s) will then print, sign, scan below waiver form and submit to the Waters Sports chair via email.

The Water Sports chair may designate another club representative to affect/schedule the transfer and forward waiver form to that individual.

The designated club representative and member(s) will meet at the storage facility or designated location. Prior to exiting their respective vehicles, all parties will don face coverings. Face coverings consist of surgical masks or improvised masks such as scarves, bandanas, and handkerchiefs to reduce the risk of exposure to others.

The unloading of the boat(s) from the club trailer and subsequent loading onto member rack/vehicle will be the responsibility of the Club member borrowing the equipment. Club member borrowing the equipment will need to have sufficient personnel to load boats onto the mode of transport they are using, the Club trailers are not available for transport. Individuals should maintain at least 6-foot distance from all parties whenever possible. Upon completion of loading, all contact surfaces on the trailers, and other applicable surfaces will be wiped down immediately by the borrowing member using appropriate sanitizers such as Lysol provided by the borrowing member.

When the member is ready to return the boat(s), the designated club representative and member borrowing the boats will meet again at the storage facility or designated location. Prior to exiting their respective vehicles, all parties will don face coverings. Face coverings consist of surgical masks or improvised masks such as scarves, bandanas, and handkerchiefs to reduce the risk of exposure to others.

The unloading of the boat(s) from the member's rack/vehicle and subsequent loading onto club trailer will be the responsibility of the Club member borrowing the equipment. Club member borrowing the equipment will need to have sufficient personnel to load boats onto the mode of transport they are using, the Club trailers are not available for transport. Individuals should maintain at least a 6-foot distance from all parties whenever possible. Upon completion of loading, all contact surfaces on the boats and paddles will be wiped down immediately using sanitizing products provided by the borrowing member. Then all parties will sanitize their hands prior to returning to their vehicles.

The designated club representative will email the Water Sports chair the completed scanned form. Note that the form must include list of names of all parties present/involved for each transaction (checking out of boats and again returning of boats) even if certain parties do not exit their vehicle.
